

What is Assessment for Learning (AfL) at NewVic?



AfL is part of everyday practice and is not an assessment at the end of your studies. You will work with your teachers to improve your learning. The feedback you receive from your teachers and peers can be written or verbal.

Different types of AfL at NewVic



PEER ASSESSMENT

This is when your work is assessed by another student. This will help you to evaluate your own learning and interpret assessment criteria.



TEACHER ASSESSMENT

This is when your teacher assesses your work and provides detailed comments. This will help you to reflect on your work and identify areas to progress your learning. You will reflect on your work by using 'Review, Reflect and Respond' (RRR).



GROUP ASSESSMENT

This is when you work in groups to evaluate the work of another group. This will help you to work cooperatively, be critical of others' work and receive feedback on your group work.



SELF-ASSESSMENT

This is when you are responsible for assessing your own work. This will help you to become an independent learner and think critically and objectively about your work.



E-ASSESSMENT

This is when Moodle and mobile technology are used to gain your feedback. This process will help you to become an independent learner, and think critically and objectively about your work.
